- ✦ There are a number of transitional issues our industry needs to be come aware of regarding the effects of the HST implementation.
- ✦ Effective July 1, 2010 the new 12% HST will be formally implemented, replacing the individual 7% PST & 5% GST.
- ✦ Industrial - Commercial - Institutional - Construction Contractors need to be aware of transitional issues that are unique to the construction sector.
- ✦ Gain understanding about companies in the contract sector that need to be aware that certain transactions have a May 31st, 2010 cut off date and the HST will apply after that.
